



## GALLIONS MOUNT SCHOOL

### Admissions Criteria for the Nursery

Parents or Carers may put their child's name on the waiting list for a nursery place once the child has reached the age of 2 years.

Admissions to the Nursery is the responsibility of the school and the following prioritised criterion are applied:

### Nursery Criteria

1. Children with a statement of special educational need/EHC Plan. Parents should consult the school to clarify this particular situation.
2. Children who are in the care of the local authority.
3. Children with a social, medical or educational need for education in a nursery class. Parents should consult the school to clarify this particular situation.
4. Greenwich Children for whom it is the nearest nursery school or class.
5. Children who are the brothers and sisters of, or who live at the same address as, pupils on the roll of the school at the time when the child starts nursery education.
6. Greenwich children for whom it is not their nearest school.
7. Children living outside the borough.

### **Admission Criteria for the Main School**

The Admissions Authority for Gallions Mount is the Local Authority, i.e. London Borough of Greenwich. The procedure and criteria for admissions is clearly set out in the Local Authority booklet 'Choosing a Nursery or Primary School in Greenwich'.
