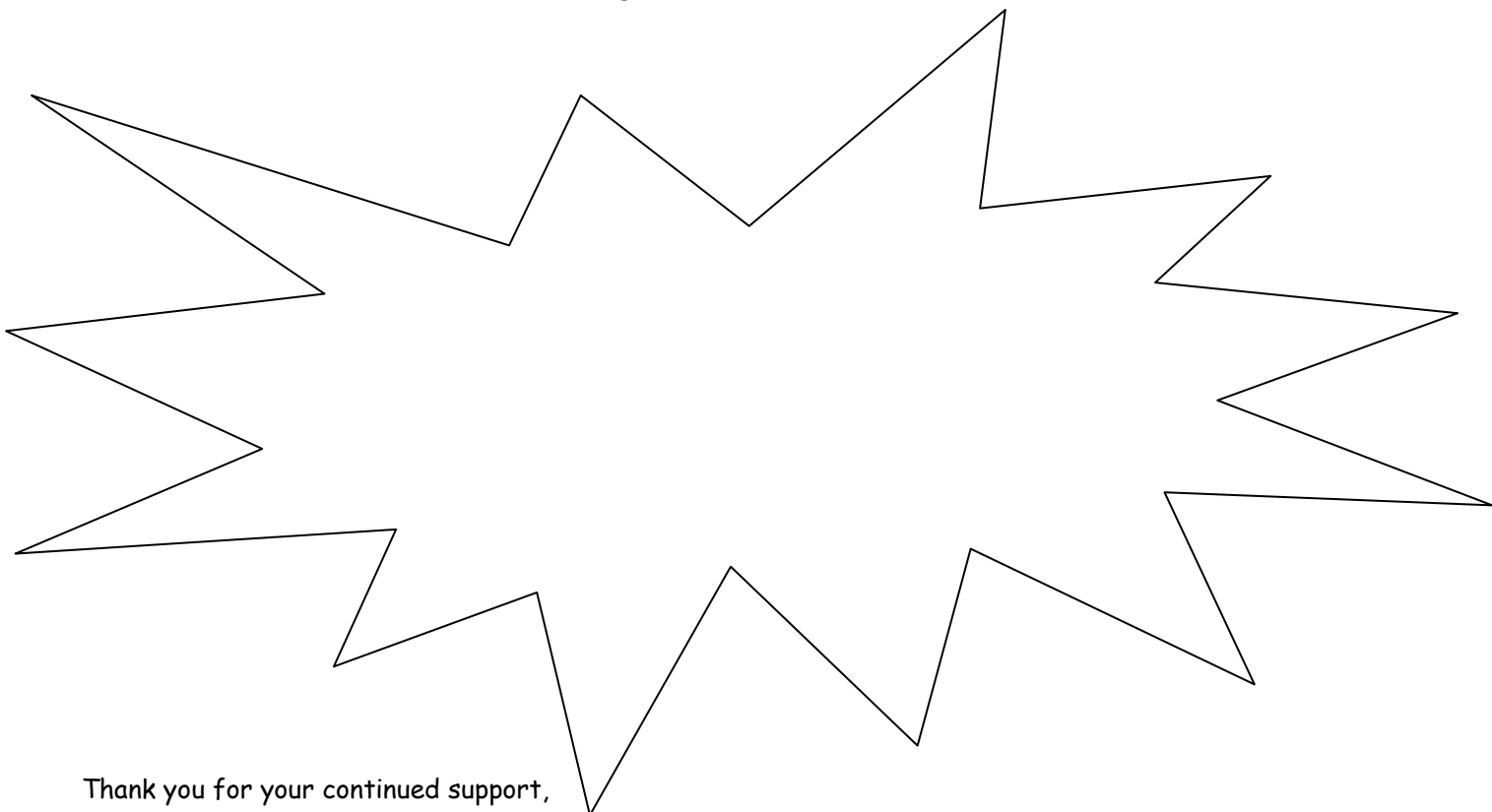
**Plumstead Library:** Our next visit to Plumstead Library will be on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April.**
